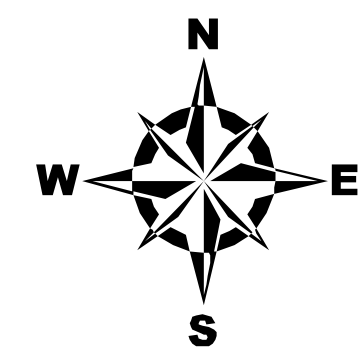
*Area Median Income (AMI) represents a 2008 adjusted median income score that is derived by the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). Adjustments to median income are made based on family size. The 2008 AMI for the Knoxville area is \$58,500 and 50% of AMI is \$29,250

**Because AMI was provided for 2008, an adjustment is necessary to make it compatible with the most recent census income data from 2000 which is representative of 1999 wages. The Consumer Price Index (CPI) was used as a basis for the conversion. During the period from 1999-August 2008, the CPI for the South region rose 27.4%. Based on this data, the 2008 AMI was converted to its equivalent 1999 dollars or \$42,471 and 50% of AMI is \$21,236. To create the map, the number of households earning less than 50% of \$25,000 was tabulated. If the percentage of households did not exceed 50% then the blockgroup is shown as hatched on the map. Census 2000 SF3 data was used to tabulate the number of households falling within each income category.

***FR scores shown of the map references the census block groups Foreclosure Risk and Abandonment Score as assigned by the HUD. Scores range from 1-10 with higher scores indicating areas with higher levels of risk for foreclosure.
