When do I need a BUILDING Permit?

What is a Building Permit?

A building permit is required by the city to construct, enlarge, alter, repair or demolish a structure or equipment installed in a building or to change the use of a building.

When do I need a Permit?

A permit is required for any substantial repairs, alterations, new buildings and additions. Minor work (under \$100 in value) such as painting, wallpapering, carpeting and routine maintenance of heating, air conditioning, plumbing or electrical systems typically do not need a permit. Permits are not required for installing a fence, putting up guttering or re-roofing a residence, if the old shingles are not torn off. WORK COMMENCING WITHOUT A PERMIT WILL BE CHARGED A DOUBLE FEE.

Who can get a Permit?

- A building permit can be obtained by the homeowner to do any building construction on a single family residence. This includes allowing someone to act as the contractor when building a new home. If you choose to hire a contractor and the valuation (after completion) of the project exceeds \$2,999.99, the contractor must be licensed by the State of TN as a general contractor with the appropriate classification and monetary limit.
- Additions to single family residences, duplexes, and triplexes whose valuation does not exceed \$24,999.99 can be performed by the owner or a State of TN licensed contractor with the appropriate classification and monetary limit.
- Repairs to duplexes and triplexes (other than owner occupied) whose valuation is \$3,000 to \$24,999.99 must be performed by either a State of TN licensed general contractor or State licensed Home Improvement contractor.
- Building construction for multi-family and commercial structures where the valuation is less than \$25,000.00 can be performed by the owner, an unlicensed contractor or a State of TN licensed general contractor.
- All building construction for multi-family and commercial structures that exceeds \$25,000.00 MUST be performed by the appropriately licensed State of TN contractor.
- Separate permits must be obtained for any electrical, gas, mechanical and plumbing work being done. In most cases, this work must be done by a City of Knoxville licensed contractor. - A sign permit is required for the erection or remodeling of all signs. Questions regarding the sign permit process should be directed to Scott Brenneman, Sign Inspector, at 865-215-2993.
- Excavating, landfill or parking lot installation or re-design are approved by City Engineering. Their office can be reached at 865-215-2148.
