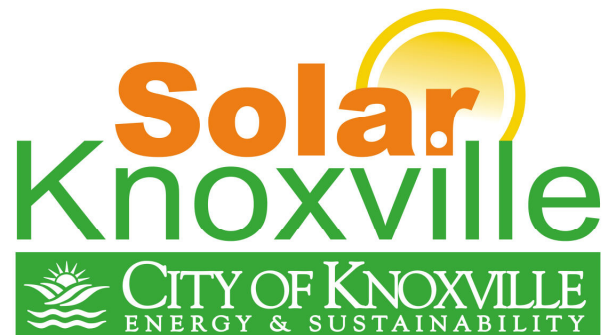


Solar Knoxville presents:
